Login as a Registry Client user. 2. Search for and select a patient. 3. Select Vaccinations->View/Add. 4. Click the Special Considerations button. 5. Click the Exemption radio button.

			<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 6. Select a Vaccine. 7. Select Parent or Patient Refusal: Religious for the Exemption reason. 8. Click the Permanent checkbox. 9. Verify that you see an alert that Permanent cannot be selected for Parent or Patient Refusals: Religious. 10. Verify that when you dismiss the checkbox the permanent checkbox is now unchecked.
