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New Features/Improvements

The following are new features, functionalities or enhancements in this version of IWeb.

CONSORT-4950	PDF for MT Complete Immunization Report - Gender	<p>The Complete Immunization Report for MT reports the patient's gender towards the top of the page.</p> <p>Steps to Test:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Login as a Registry Client user. 2. Select an Organization. 3. Select a facility. 4. Go to Patient > Search / Add. 5. Select a patient with a gender. 6. Go to Reports > State Reports > Complete Immunization Report. 7. Notice the patient's gender is reported towards the top of the page. 8. Repeat the above test with other genders.
CONSORT-4949	PDF for MT Complete Immunization Report - Group Vaccines by Family	<p>With the Complete Immunization Report for MT, Vaccines are grouped together by vaccine family.</p> <p>Steps to Test:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Login as a Registry Client user. 2. Select an Organization. 3. Select a facility. 4. Go to Patient > Search / Add. 5. Select a patient. 6. Go to Vaccination > View / Add. 7. Administer a dose of DTAP-HebB-IPV. 8. Go to Reports > State Reports > Complete Immunization Report. 9. Notice, a dose is listed once in the DTAP/DT/Td group, a second time in the POLIO group, and a third time in the HEB-B group. 10. Go back to Vaccination > View / Add and administer just a dose of DTAP. 11. Go back to the report. 12. Notice the dose is listed in the DTAP/DT/Td group. 13. Go back to Vaccination > View / Add and administer just a dose of Varicella. 14. Go back to the report. 15. Notice the dose of Varicella is reported in the VARICELLA group.

Administer a vaccine from each vaccine family that the customer includes in forecast and Reminder Recall. Note that disabling Suppress Dose1 Forecast might make for an easier test.

Go to Vaccination > View / Add and verify the historical vaccination from the second message is on the page. 17. Switch to organization 1 and select the patient. 18. Notice at organization 1, the patient is consent Yes, active, and is owned by organization 1.
CONSORT-4956	Remote Registry Error - Unable to Compile class for JSP	All	<p>Fixed the issue where an exception is displayed on Remote Registry.</p> <p>Steps to Test:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Login to IWeb as a Registry Client user. 2. Select an Organization. 3. Search for and Select a Patient. 4. Navigate to the Patient > Remote Registry. 5. Notice that Remote Registry Connections page is displayed without any errors.
