Steps to Test: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Login as a Registry Client user.2. Select a provider with Allow Provider Agreements enabled on the organization or facility maintenance page.

If only one type was entered, the report omitted the contraindication.</p> <p>Setup:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In Administration > Properties > Scheduled Reports, IWeb Address is configured correctly. <p>Steps to Test:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Login as a Registry Client user. 2. Select a facility. 3. Go to Patient > Search / Add and select a patient. 4. Go to Vaccination > View / Add. 5. Click on Special Considerations. 6. For Varicella, add a contraindication for Laboratory evidence of immunity. 7. Enter a date (either Date Documented or Additional Disease Information). 8. Add another valid, vaccination like MMR or DTAP. 9. Go to Reports > State Reports > Complete Immunization Report. 10. Locate Varicella- Laboratory Evidence of Immunity Noted towards the bottom of the report, 11. Notice the date is reported. 12. Repeat this test with the history contraindications: Patient or parent report of disease or History of Varicella Infection. 13. Locate History of Varicella Noted towards the bottom of the page. 14. Login to IWeb as a Registry Client user. 2. Go to Reports > School Reports. 3. Click on Schedule button corresponding to School Immunization Report, First Time Enterer report. 4. Select the required Report parameters from the Run Report By section. 5. Select a time to Schedule the Report or Choose Run Now. 6. Search for, Select and Click on 'Select users' button to select the School District Client user as above. 7. Select the user from the 'Selected Users (Report will be sent to users listed below)' section' 8. Click on Schedule button. 9. Verify the School District Client user received an email with the Report scheduled in Step 8. 10. Click on the link provided in the email. 11. Login with the credentials corresponding for the user (if not already logged in). 12. Notice that the report scheduled in Step 8 is displayed under Received Reports. 13.
