	Registration		Pandemic Registration feature flag enabled.
			Pandemic Registration Form Set up: To set up the desired questions for the Pandemic Registration Form, select the Create Registration Form link under the Registration Form section of the left menu when an Approving Organization is selected.
			Questions can be added to the form by selecting the Add button and removed be selecting the Delete button. The form is required to have at least one question in order for the form to be saved.
			Fields can be marked as require by selecting the Required check-box.
			Pandemic Registration Form – Provider Side: Once the Pandemic Registration Form is set up and saved. The Provider can view, fill out, and submit the form by selecting the Pandemic Registration Form link under the Registration Form section of the left menu.
			Only one form can be submitted per Organization and Facility.
			Pandemic Registration Form – Approver Side: Once the Pandemic Registration Form is submitted, the approver can view and review the forms by select the Approve Pandemic Registration Form link in the Registration section of the left menu.
			Any Pandemic Forms submitted before the new process is enabled will be available on the approve page for review and approval.
			Note: Currently, the new Pandemic Registration process will not function in Internet Explorer.
			VOMS 2.0 Customers are unable to utilize Pandemic Registration as additional changes are being made that are targeted for the March release.

HDSD-119	PHC Hub	All	 The following improvements were made to PHC Hub: In a query response, PHC Hub now includes the Name Type Code per HL7 Table 0200 for all person name fields. PHC Hub libraries were updated with the latest CDC code sets to include the latest CVX and CPT codes for COVID-19. These are CVX codes 210 and 212. In cases when a vaccine refusal is submitted, inaccurate warnings which evaluate the vaccination fields were removed.

HDSD-3078 HDSD-3129	VFC PIN/PIN	All	Previously there were multiple locations where the PIN was not displaying correctly and/or the search functionality did not work with PINs. The issues have been corrected in the following locations: • Approve Transfer page displays PINs when searching with the PIN Field. • Vaccine Returns page displays PIN Organization/Facilities. • Organization Search page displays PINs in the PIN drop down. • Facility Search page displays PINs in the PIN drop down. Previously, the property "Do Not Allow VFC PIN Entry for Organization" also limited the use of all PINs. Now if the "Do Not Allow VFC PIN Entry for Organization" property is active the user can only add PIN information. If the property is disabled, the user can add VFC PIN or PIN information.

			Closed an AART gap. Updated the code system referenced for Administrative Site to HL70163.
			In a query response, PHC Hub now includes the Name Type Code per HL7 Table 0200 for all person name fields.
			In cases when a vaccine refusal is submitted, inaccurate warnings which evaluate the vaccination fields were removed.

	Barcode Scanner	All	 MSH-21 = Z23^CDCPHINVS Previously, the barcode scanner failed to enter the correct date of birth when scanning a driver's license with <i>Patient Search > Add</i>. Now, the date of birth is populated correctly when scanning a driver's license.
	Campaign/Tier	All	Fixed issue where, when a patient was added with direct entry in IWeb without a campaign or tier, the patient was unnecessarily added to a patient campaign table in the database.
	Vaccinations	All	Fixed issue where, when two vaccinations were administered at the same time for two different vaccines (for example: Dtap and Varicella) and the Funding Source Warning Message was overridden by clicking on Save, both vaccinations were assigned the same lot number. For example, both the Dtap vaccination and the Varicella vaccination ended up with the Varicella lot number. This would impact data quality and decrementing.

HDSD-3195	Manual Patient Review	All	Fixed the Passport line of the <i>Manual Patient Review</i> screen. It was incorrectly highlighted in yellow when the numbers were different.
HDSD-2666 HDSD-3050	Mass Immunizations	All	Previously in Mass Immunizations, the Vaccination Defaults in Facility Settings was not populating the correct date. Now the following changes have been made in Vaccination Defaults in Facility Settings, so it is easier to manage the default date:
			 When a vaccinator is selected in update mode, the page loads the vaccinator and the date. The update page matches what is shown on the view page. When the vaccinator and date is loaded on the update page, the date can be cleared.
			Previously, when the <i>Enable Medicaid/Medicare ID fields</i> was enabled for Mass Immunizations, the application became unresponsive when trying to update the patient only (not add vaccinations). This has been resolved.
	Patient Edit	All	When the user selects an inactive organization, edits a patient, and clicks <i>Save</i> the application now opens a popup window with the message: "The organization selected by the user is inactive and cannot modify patients."
HDSD-1793	Patient Merge	All	Resolved an issue with the County not displaying appropriately once patients were separated. After separation, the county will now display with the patient it was initially entered for.
	Phone Numbers	All	Added a constraint to H33_Phone_Reserve table to allow only one primary phone number per IRMS_SYS_ID, IRMS_PAT_ID combination.
HDSD-3345	PHC Hub	All	Fixed issue where, when a patient failed to land in h33_patient_pre_reserve, PHC Hub incorrectly returned an MSA-1 of AA when the status code was not zero. Meaning vaccinations were getting inserted when the patient record was not inserted because of an error.
HDSD-3090	Route and Site Defaults	All	Updated the rules when setting defaults for route and site. Previously the two fields were linked together, and one default could not be saved successfully without the other. A user is now able to configure anatomical route only and have the default save to the vaccination record. A user is able to configure anatomical site only and have the default save to the vaccination record. A user is able to configure both route and site and have both fields saved to the vaccination record.
	Vaccine Family	All	Added Ebola family to ImmuCast 2.0 and updated IWeb library folder with recent immucast2 jar.

HDSD-2786	VIS Publication Date Default	All	Resolved the error that was displaying when attempting to update any of the VIS Publication Date defaults.
HDSD-1127 HDSD-2950	VFC Status	All	Previously, under Vaccinations > View/Add, the Update VFC Eligibility Update option did not work as expected impacting workflow and vaccine level accountability. Now, the application has a rule: Update the patient if the date of service is greater than the last patient update. If the vaccination date entered is less than the last update of the patient (Demographics), then the patient maintains their VFC status. If the date of the vaccine entered is greater than the last update of the patient (Demographics) then the patient is updated to the new VFC status.
HDSD-3052	CIS Certificate	MS	Previously, students were marked as Temporary Compliant instead of Requirements Met for K4 through 6 th Grade Attendance in MS. Now, the CIS form is working as expected, marking a student Requirements Met for K4 through 6 th Grade Attendance when they have the required vaccines.
HDSD-1007	State Reports	ОН	Previously, not all valid doses of Pneumococcal appear on the OH State Report. Now, the State Report includes all valid Pneumococcal doses (with the exception of PCV10).
HDSD-148 HDSD-2472	School Nurse	WA	Previously, exemptions entered through Special Considerations were incorrectly impacting the School Nurse Reports. Now, Special Considerations do not impact the School Nurse reports, only if the Special Consideration is a permanent exemption. School Exemptions do not impact the CIS certificate. Fixed an issue with the Roster calculating the Conditional Status incorrectly. Now, the WA School Nurse Module Roster calculates Conditional status as expected. Previously, WA School Nurse Module had an application error when editing and trying to save a series. Now, a
			Registry Client user can create, delete, and edit school nurse series with no error.
HDSD-2462 HDSD-2685	CIS Certificate	WA	When a patient is administered a Tdap vaccine at 7 years and the <i>Check for Tdap at 7 years or Older</i> is checked, the Tdap is valid and the CIS Certificate status is <i>Complete</i> .
