	Pandemic Registration	All	An issue with forms not displaying on the Pandemic Registration Approval page has been fixed. The following is the functionality for the approver side of Pandemic Registration Form. Pandemic Registration Form –Approver Side: Once the Pandemic Registration Form is submitted, the approver can view and review the forms by select the Approve Pandemic Registration Form link in the Registration section of the left menu. Any Pandemic Forms submitted before the new process is enabled will be available on the approve page for review and approval. Note: Currently, the new Pandemic Registration process will not function in Internet Explorer.
