Select a Provider. Go to Import Profiles > Select Import Profiles. Select an import profile. Go to Real-time Interface.

			 Submit a HL7 message like the one below where consent is no, or PD1-12 is Y. Notice the Acknowledgement message readsPatient not saved because patient expressed negative consent via PD1-12 The message should not be processed. Login to IWeb as a Registry Client user. Go to Administration > Run Deduplication and run deduplication. Select the provider. Go to Patient > Search / Add. Search for the patient. Notice the non-consenting patient was not imported into Iweb. Note: To test with the import profile setting, the patient's date of birth must be modified so that the patient is young enough to be accepted, but then rejected because of consent No.
