### **Known Issues**

The following are known issues with this release:

- The Attestation Report is currently not working.
- Version numbers do not display at the bottom of the left navigation menu.
- As previously noted in the PHC Hub v. March 2018 Release Notes, code changes are required in IWeb to complete the downstream functionality to support the relaxed consistency logic for matching VFC Eligibility and Funding Source. Clients should see fewer message rejections related to PHC Hub processing for VFC Eligibility and Funding Source, but may not see a change in lot decrementing or IIS data retention until changes have been made in IWeb.

<u>CONSORT-</u> <u>4832</u>	Fix for scheduled reports error in PHC Hub	All	Changes in this version resolve the failure to generate scheduled reports in PHC Hub. <b>Note:</b> Affected versions are 4.17.5.2+ with enabled Keycloak SSO.
<u>CONSORT-</u> <u>4834</u>	Fix for errors caused by long lot numbers	All	Messages that would otherwise be successful will err if they include lot numbers that are too long to be accepted by the SIIS table. This issue will be resolved by truncating the lot numbers to fit into the H33_VACCINATION_PRE_RESERVE table.
<u>CONSORT-</u> <u>4835</u>	Update vaccination record with non-IIS- assigned ID or name using value submitted in RXA-10	All	This fix returns the handling of non-IIS-assigned vaccinators submitted via HL7 to previous functionality. When an HL7 message includes a non-IIS-assigned vaccinator ID or name in RXA-10, the vaccination record will be updated with the value submitted in RXA-10.
<u>CONSORT-</u> <u>4836</u>	Sporadic occurrence of query responses including (or not including) the Vaccination Forecast information as expected	AII	This fixes the sporadic occurrence of query responses including (or not including) the Vaccination Forecast information as expected. Query responses will now include vaccination forecast information only when requested.
