



## **SMaRT AFIX** Release Notes

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### **Bug Fixes**

The following bug fixes are available with this release:

#### **Functional bugs:**

Resolution of rarely occurring known issue in which patients with influenza only records might not appear on the full patient list. All active patients (with or without flu or regular vaccinations) now display in their expected lists.


#### Cosmetic bugs:

- 1. Patient Lists now display "Preview of" when exported to print
- 2. Addition of tip for truncated onscreen lists: "\*You may export a full version of this report via the Export button above"
- 3. Master Rate Comparison report now includes a header with cohort name, ages, antigens and date generated.
- 4. Clarifying punctuation has been added to the antigen list.

### **Overview Page**

The following changes have been made to the Overview page:

- 1. Graph data has been updated to reflect the 2015 National Immunization Survey data (published in 2016) for the Childhood and Adolescent graphs.
- 2. Graph titles and bar labels now use "Coverage" and the year.
- 3. Footnotes at the bottom of the graph reference the National Immunization Survey and the year.
- 4. Links have been updated to the relevant MMWR 2016 publication.
- 5. Data values appear on graph bars when printed.



# Patient Active Inactive Status (PAIS)

The following changes have been made to ensure compatibility with IWeb 5.17.5:

- 1. Behind-the-scenes logic changes related to Patient status were made. The previously known issue of the inclusion of inactive patients is now resolved.
- 2. Provider relationship has been removed as a custom patient list parameter for IWEB Awardees. This option will remain available for Independent Awardees using 1:M patient-provider relationship structure.

#### **Known Issues**

#### Users should be aware of the following limitations and/or known issues that may occur:

Changes in patient status will not affect the patient's inclusion in the cohort. Patients who become inactive or are marked deceased will be continue to be included in the coverage rate calculations and patient lists of the facility with which they were previously active. This is currently being addressed and will be fixed in a patch intended for a mid-July release.

#### The following known issues were previously declared with the SMaRT AFIX 1.17.5 release:

- 1. Small numbers might be automatically formatted as dates within CSV files due to Excel formatting defaults. This is unlikely to occur in regular use cases.
- 2. Print functionality may be affected by the user electing to print prematurely. This can be remedied by allowing the display to fully load before requesting the print.
- 3. SMaRT AFIX may not always display a time-out warning. This issue will be addressed with consistency across the STC Suite of Products. In the meanwhile, if this occurs, simply sign out and log back in.
- 4. Records containing discontinued vaccines may provide atypical results.
