

## **Childhood & Adolescent Coverage Rate Reports**

The Coverage Rate Report displays the coverage rate information for a specific organization or facility, for the Childhood cohort (ages 24-35 months) or the Adolescent cohort (ages 13-17 years).


## View a Coverage Rate Report

1. Enter or select the organization/facility in the Search Bar.



2. Click either the **Childhood** > **Coverage** or the **Adolescent** > **Coverage** menu link.





3. The report opens in graph view, displaying the assessment data for the specific organization/ facility up to the current date. Each series displays the percentage of up-to-date, late upto-date (only for Childhood cohort), and missed opportunity patients. The first graph is the summary graph, which provides data on all vaccines combined in the cohort.



At the top of the report page, in the Filtering By section, the included antigens are listed (*UTD* is an acronym for *up-to-date*):

- Childhood: 1 MMR, 1 Varicella, 3 Polio, 4 DTaP, Hepatitis B, Hib, PCV, Rotavirus, 2 Hepatitis A, and Flu
- Adolescent: Hepatitis B, 2 MMR, 2 Varicella, Tdap, Meningitis, HPV, 2 Hepatitis A, Polio, and Flu
- 4. Data can be displayed in either graph (default) or table view.
  - **Graph View:** To display in graph view, click the Graph View icon ( )
  - **Table View:** To display in table view, click the Table View icon ( )

5. To view dose-level data, click on the Up-to-Date or Late Up-to-Date bars in the graph view for each antigen. (Late Up-to-Date information is only available in the Childhood report.) The Data Drill Down pop-up window appears with the information.
