## Key Terms & Icons

The following icons and key terms are used within the SMaRT AFIX application.

## Icons Used with SMaRT AFIX

Icon	Name	Description
產	Adolescent Cohort	Patients aged 13-17 years, assessed as of the date of assessment
<u>.</u>	Childhood Cohort	Patients aged 24-35 months, assessed at 24 months
*	Coverage Report	A graphic display of rates related to a series/antigens based on provider, location, VFC PIN, age, vaccine, VFC eligibility status, immunization compliance, gender, race, and/or ethnicity
0	Download / Export	Allows the user to save a copy of a report to their computer as an XML file
Ø	Edit	Allows the user to update or correct information previously entered
2	Export	Allows the user to save a report to their computer as an XLS or CSV file
alı	Graph View	Displays the data visually as a graph. Example: bar heights displaying varying coverage rate averages
	Table View	Displays the data organized in a table format, with rows and columns
<u></u>	Patient List Report	A list of patients based on provider (only one can be selected), age, VFC eligibility status, immunization compliance, gender, race, and/or ethnicity
%	Percentage	An average of how many patients, out of 100, would meet the predefined criteria
Ē	Organization	Indicates an organization
-	Facility	Indicates a facility
i	Information / Help	Displayed in the header (toward the top right of the page). Opens the SMaRT AFIX User Guide, which provides information on how to use the application, including how to run reports
٠	Print	Allows the user to print the data (in graph or table format) and/or the information displayed on the page
<	Share	Allows the user to send a saved report template to another user
	Warning	Indicates the facility's coverage rate for the relevant cohort is in the bottom quartile among the facilities in the state
0	Reset Filters	Used with custom reports. After filters have been set, click this icon to clear them and start over.
0	Preview Report	Used with custom reports. Allows the user to preview a report
0	Save Report	Used with custom reports. When filters for a report are set, click this icon to save the report template

	Log Out	To log out of the application, click this icon (located in the header bar, on the top right of the page) and then click <b>Logout</b> .
•	Applications	Click this icon (located in the header bar, toward the top right of the page) to open a panel on the right side of the page with a list of available STC applications. (Not available to all users)
