<b>Adolescent Cohort Change</b>	<p>This change impacts the inclusion of patients in the Adolescent Cohort as required to support IQIP.</p> <p>The SMaRT AFIX Adolescent Cohort now includes only patients who are 13 years of age (beginning on the 13th birthday through the day before the 14th birthday) and active with the assessed provider.</p> <p>Up to Date (UTD) compliance is measured as of the 13th birthday.</p> <p>Late UTD measurement is defined as a patient who has received the antigen between the 13th birthday and the date of assessment (today).</p> <p>Changes to the XML export to the AFIX Online Tool is out of scope for this ticket as the schema for the Online Tool has not been updated.</p>
<b>Adolescent Cohort Labeling</b>	<p>Adolescent Cohort labeling throughout SMaRT AFIX has been changed to display: <b>Ages Assessed: 13 years</b>, consistent with the logic change described above.</p> <p>This change affects the following areas:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Master Rate Comparison Adolescent Cohort report header, onscreen and in the export.</li><li>• Adolescent Cohort Coverage Report graph and table views, onscreen and in the export.</li><li>• Export to AFIX Online Tool indicates "Ages Assessed: 13 year olds" onscreen.</li></ul>

General Area	Summary
<b>Meningococcal Labeling</b>	<p>The labeling for the Meningococcal antigen has been changed from “<b>1 MENING</b>” to “<b>1 MenACWY</b>”. This affects the display in the following areas:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Filter chips at the top of the Adolescent Cohort Coverage Rate pages</li> <li>• Headers of Adolescent Cohort pages, both graph and table.</li> <li>• Headers of exported Adolescent coverage rate report</li> <li>• Header of exported Adolescent patient lists</li> <li>• Adolescent Coverage Rate report display: above the Summary Graph, above the individual antigen graph and on the axis</li> <li>• Antigen drop down in the Custom area</li> <li>• Custom area output for patient list</li> </ul> <p><b>NOTE:</b> No change has been made in this release for meningococcal calculation or forecasting. This is a labeling change <u>only</u>.</p>

## Known Issues

The following are known issues with this release:

- STC is investigating a scenario which impacts custom reports, causing “Service Unavailable” error. Users who experience this error are encouraged to select additional parameters (such as VFC Eligibility or Patient Demographics) to limit the report until a solution can be released.
- An issue has been identified in the custom template sharing functionality. Currently, organization level users cannot view reports for their child facilities. This issue will be prioritized with the CDC and handled accordingly.
- When exported to a CSV file, a facility's rank on the Master Rate Comparison report may display as a date. This is an Excel default formatting issue and is not related to the SMaRT AFIX application. Users can manually set the column formatting to change the date to a number to address the issue.
