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# New Features

The following new features are included in this release:

1. New versioning! We bet you're tired of those tongue-twister version numbers, too. We're making it simpler, starting with this version, which is now conveniently called *March 2018*.
2. Provider Group User functionality. This Consortium-requested functionality will allow select AFIX-level users to be assigned to groups of facilities/organizations that are otherwise not affiliated. Complete user information for this new functionality can be found in the [SMaRT AFIX User Guide](#) (also available inside the application). Also see the SMaRT AFIX role assignments table, below.
3. Test scripts have been updated with corrections and the addition of scenarios to support your testing of the Provider Group User functionality. The updated scripts are available on [Confluence](#) and on the [STC Documentation Portal](#).
4. ETL server restart and ETL application user improvements.
5. We've updated the [API Documentation](#) to reflect a few recent changes.

Active VFC Eligibility Status	Changes were made to bring only active VFC eligibility codes into SMaRT AFIX, resolving an issue that caused patient files to be rejected.

## Known Issues

The following are known issues with this release:

- The CDC recently announced changes to meningococcal logic and VFC Provider Status. We'll get to work on those modifications right after this release. For now, the Master Rate Comparison Report remains the same, and so does the meningococcal logic.
- We'll address a known issue resulting from a rare combination of immunization record edits that impact UTD calculations. This has been found to impact .001% (or fewer) patients. It's still too frequent for our comfort, however, and we'll add a fix for this issue to the next release.
- An error will occur in Custom Reports when selecting the same vaccine twice.
