**IWeb 5.34.0 must be installed for VOMS 2.29.0 to function.**

|     | Prebooking | <p><b><u>IWeb 5.34.0 must be installed for VOMS 2.29.0 to function.</u></b></p> <p>The restriction on Prebooking that only allowed one order set has been removed.</p> <p>A new section has been added to Admin &amp; Settings, called Define Prebooking Categories. The state can now set up categories with up to three order sets assigned to the category for Prebooking. An Organization/Facility can only be assigned to one order set within a category.</p> <p>Category drop-downs have been added to the following locations to allow providers and the state to switch between categories.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Prebooking Provider Request form</li> <li>• Assign Provider to Prebooking</li> <li>• Prebooking Percentage Allocations</li> <li>• Approver Prebooking – Update Provider Forms</li> </ul> <p>The Prebooking Percentage Allocation page will pull all vaccines in all order sets for the selected category. If a vaccine is in multiple order sets, it will only be displayed once and the allocation set will be used for all order sets.</p> <p>The Approve Prebooking – Fulfill Prebooking Request page will pull all vaccines in all order sets for the selected category. If the provider is assigned to an order set that doesn't have a given vaccine the Fulfillment Doses box will be greyed out.</p> <p>The following properties have been removed or moved to a new location on the Property page.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Provider Submission Date Range – property has been removed. Date Range is set on Define Category page.</li> <li>• Restrict Funding Source – property has been removed as it is no longer needed.</li> <li>• Enabled Prebooking – is now located on the General tab.</li> </ul> <p><b><u>IWeb 5.34.0 must be installed for VOMS 2.29.0 to function.</u></b></p> |

# Fixed Bug Details

The following table lists the detailed information about each of the bugs fixed in this version.

| Key                      | Summary    | Impact & Description  |
|--------------------------|------------|---|
| <a href="#">HDS-672</a>  | Inventory  | Previously, inactive Products would display in the Vaccine Selection drop-down when adding inventory to the application. Now, only active Products will display in the Vaccine Selection drop-down when adding inventory.   |
| <a href="#">HDS-1157</a> | Prebooking | Previously, the application required percentage allocations to be submitted before another one could be added. This wouldn't allow any percentage allocations to be submitted. Now, a percentage allocation does not need to be submitted in order to submit another one. |
